SEMESTER 1

INTRODUCTION TO COMPUTER GRAPHICS AND MEDIA DESIGN

(Theory & Practical)

- Acquire knowledge on design aesthetics
- Learn the professional software Adobe Illustrator, Adobe Photoshop and Adobe InDesign
- Learn in detail about the print media designs

- Typing a content in English or Malayalam with a standard typing speed

- Practise the process of translation between English and Malayalam

- Edit the content for different media platforms

- Proof check the printed material of news or other publications
- Translate from Malayalam to English and vice versa for print media

PHOTOGRAPHY AND PHOTOJOURNALISM (Practical)

- Learn the history of photography and its relevance in contexts
- Handle a professional, semi professional and digital camera
- Learn the basic rules of professional photography
- Understand the basics of lighting for photography
- Acquire knowledge on different angles, camera movements and shots.
- Understand photojournalism and its importance
- Make photographs tell a story

Upon the completion of this course, students will be able to

- Cover an event with still photographs
- Use professional camera and integrated equipment
- Take photographs for events, functions or outdoor advertising
- Cover a soft story with photographs
- Evaluate a photograph based on its composition and quality
- Prepare photo stories on human interested themes

AUDIO RECORDING, EDITING AND SOUND DESIGN (Theory & Practical)

Course Outcomes:

As a course in Broadcasting & Journalism, student will be able to

- Understand the basics of sound, the theories behind sound production and propagation, etc.
- Learn the process of sound recording using different devices
- Get familiar with different types of microphones and sound equipment
- Practise the process of sound recording in different contexts using different equipment
- Learn software for audio recording and editing such as Cool Edit Pro, Adobe Audition, Avid Pro tools etc.
- Understand the process of creating sound for particular scenes and recording foley for movies

Upon the completion of this course, students will be able to

- Record Voice Overs for different Radio or Television programmes
- Record Sound Effects using different devices
- Handle sound recording equipment and sound studio
- Manage studio sound recording process
- Handle digital and analogue mixers with multiple inputs
- Create sound designs for particular scenes or given situations
- Edit recorded sounds for different output formats and purposes
- Record foley for short films
- Evaluate the quality of sound production, recording and output
- Edit multi-track content for radio or television
- Edit sound for different purposes using Audio Recording and editing software

RADIO BROADCASTING (Theory & Mini Project)

- Acquire knowledge about different types of radio station, their mission and visions
- Learn the basics of radio broadcasting techniques
- Understand various types of programmes aired on Radio
- Learn the history of radio in India
- Understand the relevance and importance of radio communication in today's context
- Get familiar with programme patters, scripts and content for radio

- Evaluate the radio programmes based on their quality, content and technical aspects of production
- Prepare content for different genres of radio programmes
- Write script for various radio productions
- Record the content and/or present the content for a radio production
- Produce a radio programme from concept to final output

MEDIA LAWS AND ETHICS

- Learn the laws and acts in India supporting media ethics

VIDEO RECORIDNG, EDITING AND VISUAL DESIGN (Theory & Practical)

Course Outcomes:

- Learn the basics of video recording equipment and its operation
- Practise with different types of video camera, sound and lighting equipment
- Understand the basic rules and principles of videography in different contexts
- Learn the technical aspects of video recording process and the theories behind
- Understand the functions of different shots, angles and movements in videography
- Learn the basics of video editing using software like Adobe Premiere Pro, FCP
- Practise to create a visual design for a particular scene or given situation

Upon the completion of this course, students will be able to

- Develop a skill of handling video recording equipment and integrated sound, light devices
- Assist professional videography crew for multi-camera production set up
- Cover events or programmes with audio visual content
- Edit and produce the video output in different formats as per the requirement using software such as Adobe Premiere Pro and FC
- Analyse the video production and check the technical and aesthetical quality
- Observe video production unit and suggest updates
- Produce audio visual content for various events or programmes
- Design a visual platform for events or programmes to be covered with videography.

MOBILE JOURNALISM (Theory & Practical)

Course Outcomes:

As a course in Broadcasting & Journalism, student will be able to

- Understand the relevance of mobile journalism in today's context
- Lear the history and background of MoJo in the world, with special reference to India
- Understand the content that can be easily produced with MoJo units.
- Learn the technical and aesthetical aspects of mobile production of journalistic content
- Acquire knowledge to operate different mobile devices for MoJo productions
- Acquire knowledge to be familiar with different platforms of mobile operating systems such as Android and iOS
- Get familiar with different mobile applications used for MoJo productions
- Practise the usage of integrated equipment to be used with different mobile handsets for MoJo productions
