## Annual Review Report 2022-23

In the final week of August 2023, PQAC conducted annual reviews of project execution and PQAC report implementations in all of the UG and PG departments of Sullamussalam Science College.

We are pleased that several departments have made considerable efforts to raise student knowledge of the academic endeavour and encourage a research mindset. They found the PQAC ideas and suggestions to be really helpful and have taken the appropriate actions to share them.

### Key Findings

1. The majority of them made an effort to use the PQAC-recommended thesis template.
2. As compared to prior years, the quality of the projects' works and problems addressed have improved.
3. Many of the departments adapted modelling and statistical techniques for analysis.
4. Research culture and awareness is yet to be fully achieved.
5. **Not many have focused on the outcomes.**
6. Not many projects have been turned into Publications/ Innovations/ participation in conferences / seminar presentations. A few departments that need to be acknowledged are UG [Commerce, Economics] as well as in PG [Physics, Computer Science].
7. **Unavailability of previously requested facilities from the college have directly affected the smooth execution of projects.**

### Suggestions

- ✚ Reading space and computer access for every department with proper time schedule.
- ✚ Project Coordinators should be fixed for a minimum three-year time period with specific duties.
- ✚ Department level journals with ISBN.
- ✚ Focus on Outcome-based project.
- ✚ Two project presentations in departments are mandatory.
- ✚ Research based programmes are mandatory at the department level.
- ✚ Impart at least a skill/technique via project
- ✚ Special fund allocation for project and related events.
- ✚ Proper student feedback gathering and corrective action.
