

Anti-Ragging Policy of Sullamussalam Science College, Areakode

Sullamussalam Science College, Areakode, is committed to providing a safe and inclusive environment for all its students. The college strictly adheres to the University Grants Commission (UGC) Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009. The following measures define the college's anti-ragging policy:

1. Definition of Ragging

Ragging includes any physical, verbal, or psychological abuse of a student by their peers, especially seniors, that causes harm, humiliation, or distress.

2. Preventive Measures

Awareness Programs: Anti-ragging awareness campaigns, such as seminars and orientation sessions, are organized regularly for students and staff.

Affidavit Submission: All students and their parents must submit an anti-ragging affidavit at the time of admission, as mandated by the UGC.

Signage and Information: Anti-ragging notices and helpline numbers are prominently displayed across the campus to remind everyone of the zero-tolerance policy.

3. Anti-Ragging Committee and Squad

The college has constituted an Anti-Ragging Committee and an Anti-Ragging Squad:

Anti-Ragging Committee: Comprising faculty members, administrative staff, and student representatives, it oversees the implementation of the anti-ragging policy and resolves complaints.

Anti-Ragging Squad: A dedicated team monitors the campus, hostels, and other vulnerable areas to prevent any instances of ragging.

4. Complaint Mechanism

Students can report ragging incidents confidentially to faculty members, the anti-ragging squad, or the grievance cell.

Complaints can also be submitted via email or a designated helpline.

5. Disciplinary Action

Strict disciplinary action is taken against individuals found guilty of ragging, which may include:

Suspension or expulsion from the college.

Filing an FIR if the incident warrants legal intervention.

Cancellation of scholarships or other privileges.

6. Support for Victims

The college ensures that victims of ragging receive counseling and support to overcome the trauma.

Sullamussalam Science College remains vigilant and proactive in maintaining a ragging-free campus, fostering a culture of mutual respect and harmony.
