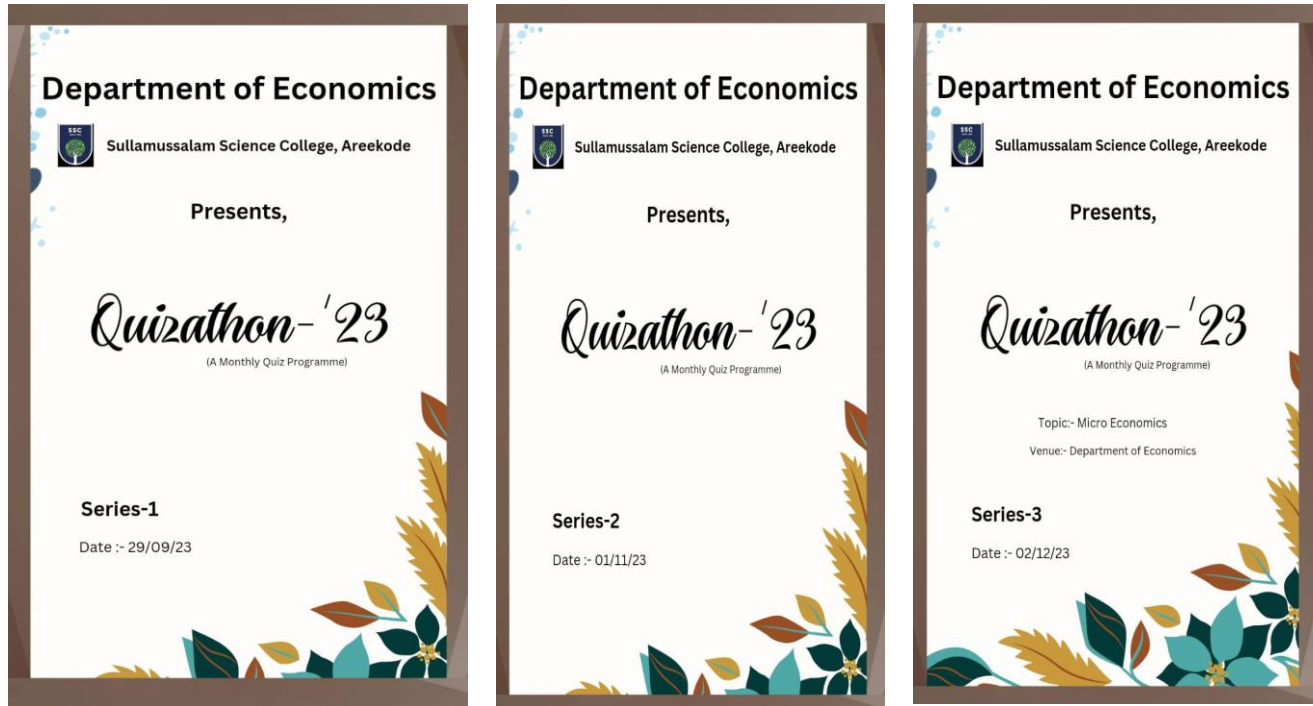
Project Proposal Presentation on 21st, September 2023.

ECON SEMINAR SERIES:Role of Economics in Data Analytics

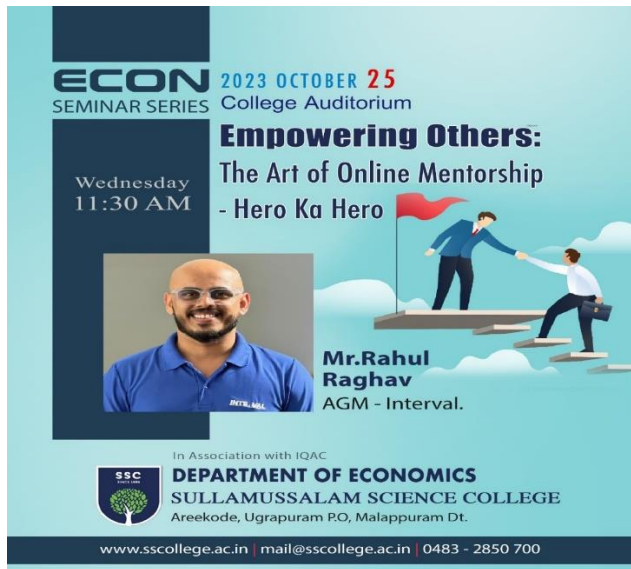
